

Guess game

This guess game provides you with an introduction to water conservation in Europe. Specifically, it introduces, in a playful way, the state of implementation for water conservation policies in all of the European Union (EU) countries - and some more as you will see when playing the game.

Game instructions

For this game you need a computer with Microsoft Power Point or a Pdf viewer. If you play it as a group, which we recommend, you need a whiteboard, beamer or large screen so that everyone can see the slides. When you open the PowerPoint version, open it in presentation mode to play the game.

Before playing this game as a group, divide your group into two or more subgroups, and appoint one volunteer to keep track of points (this person keeps track of the points collected by each group). The group with the most points wins.

When playing the game, you will need to guess that state of implementation of the WFD in different European countries. We will use these symbols to represent the current status of implementation and the quality of water:



Good





Moderate



Poor and Bad

If you get it right, you get 3 points, and if you get it wrong, you get -1 point.
